Meet Sharona

In 2020, you helped rescue Sharona*—whose mother took her own life and whose father abandoned her. Left alone with her aging grandmother, Sharona was almost traf-

ficked for \$200 USD. But because of your support, we could show up for Baby Sharona in her most vulnerable moments. Her story is now being rewritten.



WHAT YOU CAN DO

RESCUING & EMPOWERING

\$100 helps give a survivor one month of trauma counseling.

\$300 helps fund a girl's rescue from female gendercide.

\$30,000 helps rescue 100 girls from female gendercide.
